I was born onto the union of Mr & Mrs. Tengbeh Saah Lendor of Sadu Passia town Rankollie clan Foya Statutory District, Lofa County, North-East Liberia in October, 1976. I began my primary education at Kpakio elementary school in 1983 and completed secondary education in Gueckedou, the Republic of Guinea.

I began ministry work with the Evangelical Lutheran Church at Farakor congregation in Gueckedou Guinea as Sunday school teacher. After serving the church fervently for 3 years, the church appointed me as their assistant Pastor before sending me to Sierra Leone in Bo District to study at CCTS (Coordinating Center for Theological Studies) a Lutheran seminary in Sierra Leone to train pastors and church leaders. After my successful graduation from CCTS in 2006, I immediately returned to Liberia to help with work of the ministry in Foya, Lofa County. Moreover, upon my turn I began training lay leaders and Parish leadership in the three parishes. Because of the series of training, the churches began to grow and extended beyond the previous (12) congregations that I met in 2006.

Therefore, after taking on leadership to stir the affairs of the church as senior Pastor for Foya Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church and District president for Lofa in 2007 to 2021, I established 9 additional congregations and preaching points around the District with two leading schools that are helping hundreds of children in the district with quality education.

I am married to my wife Abie T. Saah with four kids: three girls and one boy. My passion is winning souls for the Kingdom of God, and my focus is empowering my colleagues in ministry to be equipped with the knowledge of sharing Jesus Christ to the dying souls in the world.
